





INTERFACE

Quick Access speeds up the search for materials in your folders. So you can quickly **IMPORT FILES** by selecting paths from the **MAIN LIST** or by clicking on this **BUTTON**.



Quick Access creates the history of paths, which includes all the latest After Effects paths.

MAIN LIST



The top section of the list is **FAVORITES**, the lower is Recent Paths (QA **HISTORY**).

SETTINGS

Click this button to open the **SETTINGS WINDOW**



Click this button with **CTRL/CMD** TO **UPDATE** the List of Recent Paths.

Settings



ADDING PATHS TO FAVORITES

- By clicking the button **ADD SELECTED PATHS TO FAVORITES** ;
- By manual input, or by inserting a path into the text field. After that press Enter.



- By clicking the plus button .

THE PATHS IN THE FAVORITES LIST CAN BE


- sorted  ;
- edited (by double-clicking on the item);
- removed .

FOLDER BUTTON



Allows you to open a folder with the address of the selected item in any list. Also you can import files by double clicking on any item of any list in the Settings window, except for the list of Favorites (double click on the item of this list opens the window for editing the path and alias).

OPTIONS



ALIASES checkbox allows to use short names instead of full paths.

FAVORITERS checkbox enables Favorites path in the Main List.


HISTORY checkbox enables History path in the Main List.

NUMBER OF RECENT PATHS text field sets number of History paths displayed in the Main List.

THE RIGHT SIDE OF THE SETTINGS WINDOW CONTAINS FOUR TABS WITH PATHS:

- The **QA HISTORY** Tab contains common recent paths of AE Projects, Render Queue and paths of the import.
(Note: if you import files by using the built-in After Effects tools, you need to refresh the History by clicking the Refresh Button , or by clicking the Settings Button  with **Ctrl/Cmd**);
- The **AE HISTORY** Tab contains paths of recent After Effects projects and the paths, received by AE Import in the native way;
- The **PROJECT PANEL** Tab contains unique file paths that are located in the AE Project panel;
- The **RENDER Q** Tab contains unique paths of rendered files from AE Render Queue.

LOAD AE HISTORY FROM AE PREF FILE



You can do this by checking the **"FROM PREF FILE"** checkbox. This may be necessary if the regional characters in the paths are not displayed correctly. This checkbox is set by default in the version of the After Effects CS6 and older.
